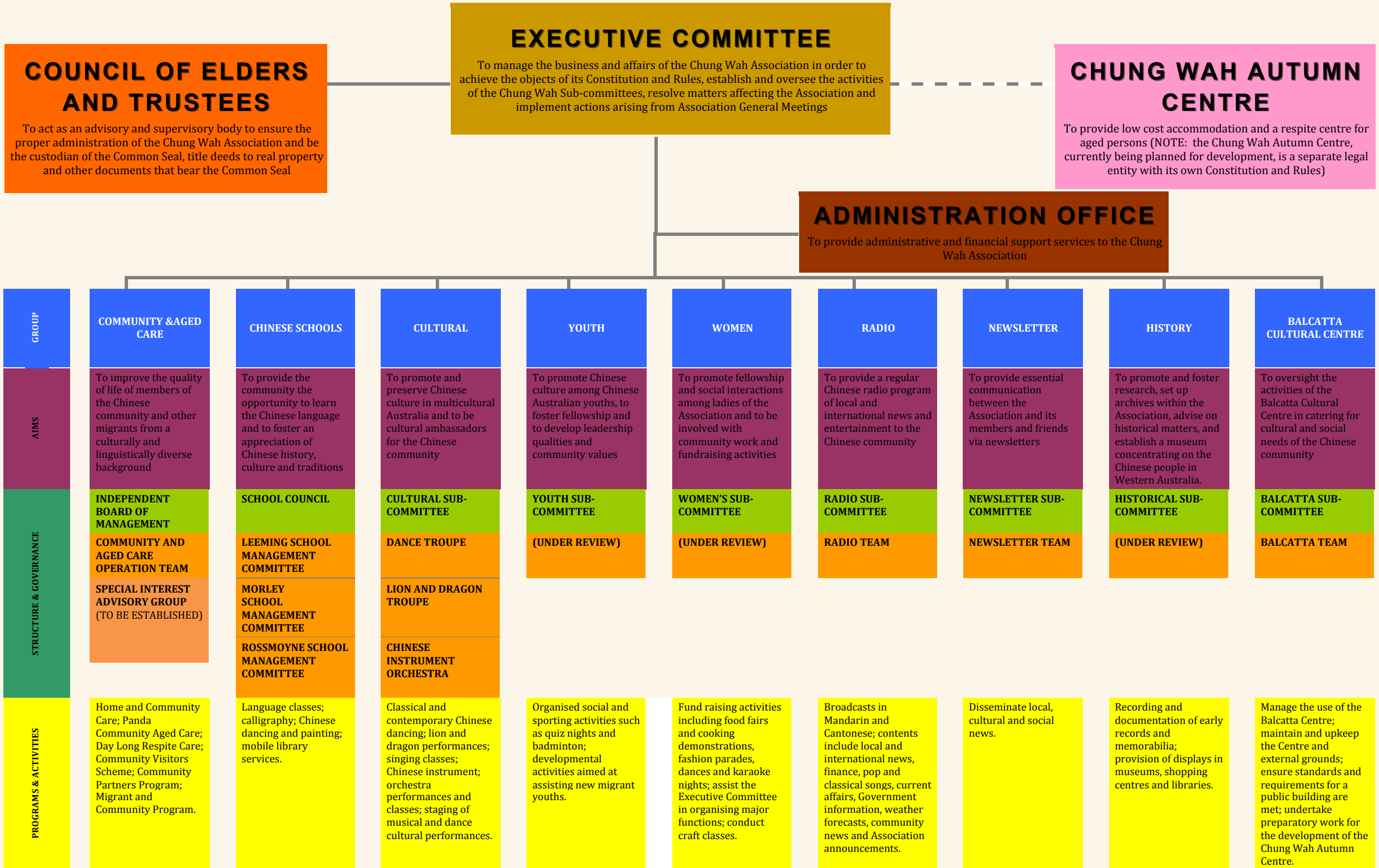


CHUNG WAH ASSOCIATION (INC) WA ①



EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

COUNCIL OF ELDERS AND TRUSTEES

To act as an advisory and supervisory body to ensure the proper administration of the Chung Wah Association and be the custodian of the Common Seal, title deeds to real property and other documents that bear the Common Seal

CHUNG WAH AUTUMN CENTRE

To provide low cost accommodation and a respite centre for aged persons (NOTE: the Chung Wah Autumn Centre, currently being planned for development, is a separate legal entity with its own Constitution and Rules)

To provide administrative and financial support services to the Chung Wah Association
