## SCHOOL VISITS' GENERAL INFORMATION SHEETS

**General Information:** The Chung Wah program is suitable for students from Year 3 through to Years 12. It has been operating since September, 1999, and all activities are subject to availability of the volunteers, at the time of the request.

It is desirable to make bookings at least three (3) weeks in advance so an individual program can be devised and helpers rostered. The earlier the booking, the better chance of securing your preferred time slot, etc.

**Day Available :** Fridays (during school term)  
**Times :** 10:30am through to 3:00pm

**Numbers of Students per session:** 10 Students (Minimum)  
35 Students (Maximum)

**Session Lengths:** Minimum of 1.5 hours (adequate for Year 3 students).  
Usually 2 hour per session. However, all day program can be arranged.

**Activities:** The Hall Tour, Northbridge trail and Herbalist visits require Half an hour and are designed for high school students.

- The '**Restricted Entry**' secondary education kit and the '**Hand in Hand**' the primary education package is also available from the Association.
- **Both education kits are now free of charge, courtesy of the National Trust of Australia (WA).**
- The Oral history activity is generally for senior secondary students.

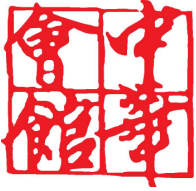
All the other activities are 'hands on' and can take between 15-30 minutes, depending on a teacher's requirements for the visit.

### SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- **Paper cutting and the history of paper making** require students to bring scissors and glue sticks.
- Copies of work sheets with tour and trail questions are required for each Student doing the Northbridge trail and or the Hall tour. (see 'Restricted Entry' for worksheets and questions)
