Fundraising Appeal

Chung Wah is building a new community centre to serve the community living South of the river. This community centre will be used by Chung Wah Community Care for respite services for their clients during weekday daytimes. At other times, the new Community Centre would be used to hold dinners, functions and concerts and be a regular place for cultural activities such as Chinese dance, orchestra and Chinese classes, among others. The community centre will be the home for Chinese people South of the river and open for other communities to use.

The Chung Wah Community Centre Bentley is designed as a two-storey building with open spaces and outdoor amenities. The construction will also include a car park and garden.

Location

The building will be situated at the corner of Hedley Street and Nyamup Way, Bentley, Western Australia. The site size is around 7,000m2. The land is located in the City of Canning and is being sub-divided by Development WA. The land was kindly granted to the Chung Wah Association by the State government.

Building Cost

- The total Building Cost for Stage 1 is \$9 million.
- Chung Wah Association will receive a total of \$6.75 million from the WA State and Federal Government. We greatly appreciate their support.
- The Fundraising Target for Stage 1 is \$1 million by December 2024.
